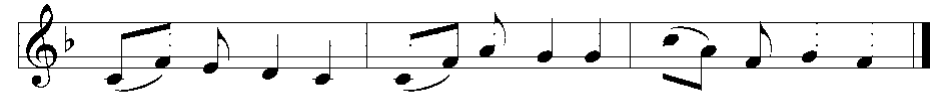

Epistle *2 Thessalonians 2:13–17*

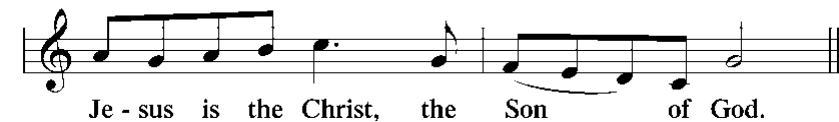

The Third Article
